When you pour yourself into a house, it blossoms into a beautiful home that reveals so much about you. As you are choosing those elements of your home that will combine to make it just the way you want it, it will likely dawn on you as some point that, while there appear to be numerous elements to choose from, most of them have been pre-packaged to some degree.

The journey to find the cabinetry that best suits you will be no different. Unless your cabinetry allocation allows for truly high-end custom cabinetry, chances are that the combinations of door styles and woods will be limited to only a few dozen styles, but will be dressed up to look like more by showing them in various finishes. If you want more say over the details of your cabinetry, then you are the reason why Harmony exists.

Within the realm of consumer products, it has been generally accepted that compromises must be reached between selection and value. Nowhere does that tension exist more than in building products. Over 50 years ago, our family business set out to challenge that notion.

For example, in the mid 1990's, we noticed that glazed, distressed and antiqued finishes were gaining popularity. No one thought they could be produced in an affordable manner. Our Smart Styles finish program made those fashions affordable and within a decade, every major manufacturer followed suit with their own antique finishes.

Once, inset cabinetry was considered off limits for the average budget. The prevailing thought was that the tolerances needed couldn't be met in an affordable manner. Our research said otherwise and we surprised the industry by offering affordable inset cabinetry. Several other semi-custom companies have followed suit since that time.

When we began to see an increased interest in painted finishes, we quickly recognized that having a palette of 10 or 20 standard paint colors would not be the answer for our clients. Our custom paint program proved, once again, that you don't have to pay through the nose to get what you want. Only recently, several of our competitors were still scrambling to catch up. We soon followed up with our custom stain program. Why should custom stains be limited to high-end cabinetry?

The selections you will find available to you from Harmony Cabinetry are the next logical step towards giving you almost unlimited choices. Over the years, we have noticed that a given door or drawer front may be satisfactory to a client, but it could have been their ideal choice if only a detail or two could have been changed. We also found that clients wanted the ability to mix different types of doors and drawer fronts together to achieve their own personalized style.

We have chosen to name this company Harmony because we feel that it is a pefect blend of flexibility and value.

In the pages that follow, we have set out the different elements that you can control, and have tried, where possible, to show how different details can result in different looks. As you look through these pages, please understand that we can only show a small sample of the literally millions of combinations possible. If you want to learn more about the options available to you, consider scheduling a visit with your local Harmony Dealer.

## **Lower Doors**

For lower doors, you get to make all of the same choices you made for upper doors. Do you want the lower doors to be the same as the upper doors, or do you want them to be different?

When deciding upon cabinetry, the type of wood to be used is often the first consideration. We offer 9 different woods to accomodate a broad range of tastes. Some woods, such as Maple, are fairly versatile and complement both formal and casual settings. Other woods, such as Rustic Oak, lend themselves to a more focused range of fashions.

To attempt to provide you with a neutral palette for comparing wood species, we have used a transitional door style with an uncluttered center panel, paired with a simple drawer front. Once you have selected the type of wood that you feel best suits your

tastes and a door style from the pages that follow, try to picture what the combination of door style and wood will look like. Also give some thought to how the wood specie will affect the color you have chosen. If you feel that the door style, wood specie and finish are that perfect combination for your home, ask if your Harmony dealer has any samples that might help you confirm your choices.

Please note that not all species are available for all door styles. For more information, please consult with your Harmony dealer. Also if considering a Rustic Wood or Knotty Alder, please be aware that door frames, face frames and moldings will not exhibit rustic characteristics, as they are structural components, nor will plywoods for Rustic offerings.

The term Overlay is used to describe the amount that doors and drawer fronts overlap the front frames of cabinets. This page and the next show how overlay has a considerable impact on fashion. Below are four cabinet fronts of the same door style and finish. The only difference between them is the overlay.

Full overlay cabinetry is versatile enough for any setting, but is often associated with contemporary styling. 1/2" overlay cabinetry is seen most in traditional settings and has been a standard for several decades. Inset cabinetry has historic roots, but has also been used extensively of late in transitional styling. Beaded Inset Cabinetry, a more ornate form of inset cabinetry, features machined beading on the front frames. This adds additional decor, as well as another highlighted surface for glazed finishes.

The images below show our four overlay options in a section of a kitchen. We've used the same door style details, finish options and accessorization so that you can see the difference in a neutral environment.

When considering traditional frame and panel cabinet doors, one aspect of the door style that the homeowner rarely gets to choose is the width of the stiles and rails of the doors (in simpler terms, the outer frame of the doors). And yet this seemingly small detail is a key architectural element. Below are pictures of both raised panel and flat panel door styles. The pictures on the left side of the page feature doors with 2 1/4" outer frames, while the pictures on the right size of the page feature doors with 3" outer frames. See what a difference it makes?

As you look through the different door styles shown on later pages, you will find that, whenever possible, we offer you a choice between narrow or wide door stiles and rails, so that you can choose the look which best suits your taste.





On each side of the page both shallow and deep drawer fronts are shown, as certain physical characteristics may vary depending upon height.



When looking at different types of cabinetry, most people pay careful attention to the doors. Though often an afterthought, drawer fronts are also a key fashion component worthy of careful consideration. That's why we offer so many choices and why we allow you the option of choosing one type of drawer front for shallow drawers and a completely different type of drawer front for deep drawers.

Below, we have taken a fairly conservative door in a traditional finish, and have paired it with three different drawer fronts. All three of these fronts reinforce the traditional feel of the door, but notice how differently each drawer front impacts the overall look. The drawer front on the left is simpler, while the drawer front on the right is more ornate. The more ornate drawer might, at first glance, seem to be a more elegant option simply because it is more decorative. Yet if you've seen some of today's transitional styles with their simple clean lines and plain drawer fronts, you've probably realized that each of these three drawer fronts can be elegant in the proper setting.

## **Wood Finishes**

Our wood coatings consist of stains, base coats, paints, glazes, veiling lacquer and crackle lacquer. Edgewear and Physical Distress techniques are also available. Here are some general guidlines as to how the various coatings and techniques can be applied:

- Any of our stains may be applied to any of our woods. Stains are standard on some woods and non-standard on others.
- Any of our base coats and paints may be applied to any of our woods, except for Hickory and Rustic Hickory.
- Veiling Lacquer, Crackle Lacquer or any of our glazes may be applied to any of our stains or base coats. Some combinations are standard, some are non-standard.
- Edgewear and/or Physical Distress techniques may be applied to any of our stains or basecoats, with or without glazes.




